
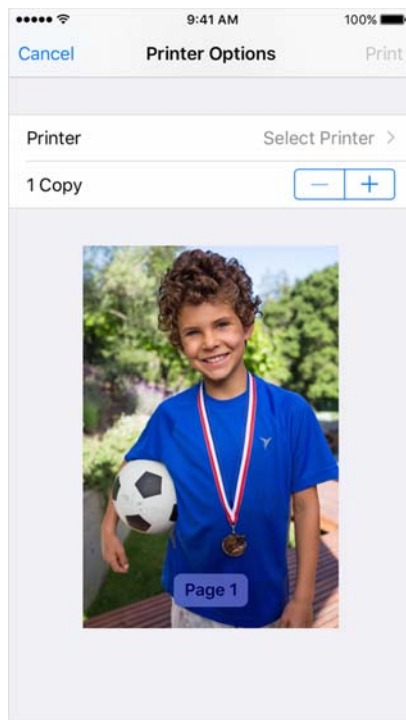


Use AirPrint to print from your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch

Learn how to print from your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch to an AirPrint-enabled printer.

You can print from your iOS device to any [AirPrint-enabled printer](#):

1. Open the app you want to print from. Find the print option by tapping the app's share icon (↵ or ↗) or settings icon (⚙️ or ⚙️). If you can't find the print option, check the app's User Guide or Help section. Not all apps support AirPrint.
2. Tap  or Print.
3. Choose an [AirPrint-enabled printer](#).
4. Choose the number of copies.
5. Tap Print.

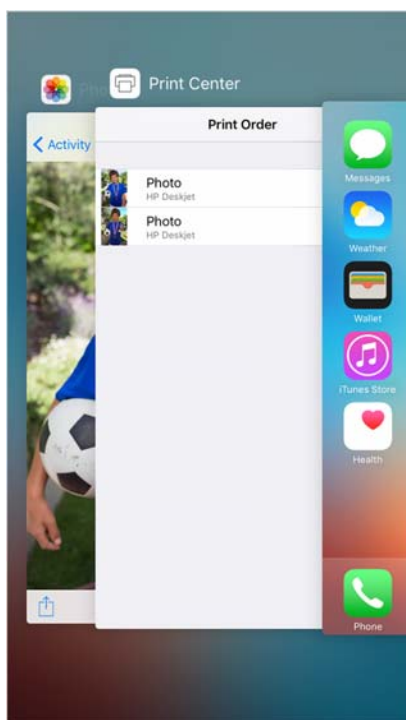


If you don't see your printer, make sure that:

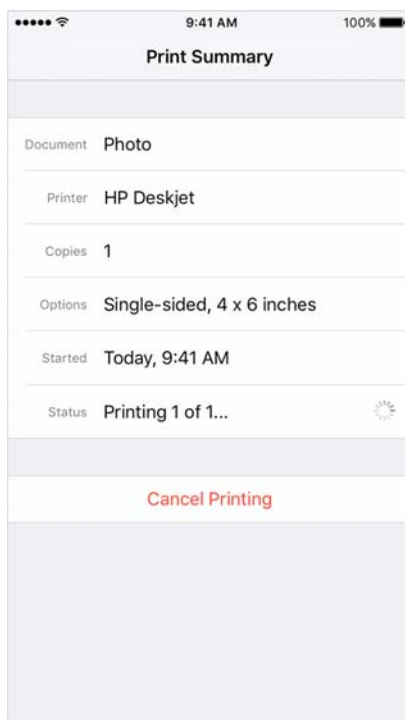
- Your iOS device and your printer are connected to the same Wi-Fi network and you're within range.
- Your [printer supports AirPrint](#).

View or cancel your print job

While printing, you can view your print jobs or cancel them through the App Switcher.



To view a print job, double-click the Home button and tap Print Center.



To cancel a print job, double click the Home button, tap Print Center, then tap Cancel Printing.
